At St. Xavier's college, we admit only the best. Outstanding score in entrance exam is one of the main selection criteria to get admitted into our college. Along with outstanding score in entrance exam & good performance in succeeding interview, our prospective students generally excel in their secondary school as well as participate and surpass their peers in various extracurricular activities.

We admit students to complete their final two years of education in high school before pursuing undergraduate degree. We also offer various undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in our college.

Class profile for students admitted in high school (2011-13) – HSEB students

This year's class was chosen from an applicant pool of over **8000+** prospective students, out of which only **510** students were accepted and **504** of those selected students enrolled into our college.

Our diversity is reflected on the fact that selected students came from **300+** different secondary schools representing almost **70+** districts in Nepal. (*Note: There are total 75 districts.*)
